Update

The following recommendations have been submitted and approved:

- **Match Guidance-** providing guidance on the match requirement for ASES programs
- **FPM Tips Sheet** – providing an overview of the top five findings, identifying common issues and providing resources.
- **FAQ revision to incorporate new legislation-** incorporating FAQ's to reflect changes in AB 2622 and SB 816.
- **Evaluating attendance the first 6 months-** If new sites are not meeting 50% of their attendance for the first 6 months, they will be identified as critical.
- **Addressing programs who continually get reduced and then increased funding** -programs will have to wait 2 years before they are able to apply for additional funding if they get reduced. Additionally, they will have to provide evidence that they can support additional students with an increase.
- **Addressing minimum funded grants**—school sites that have a minimum grant amount and at least 60 students in the school and are not meeting their attendance will be identified as critical.

We are currently working on the following emerging issues:

- Unexpended grant funds
- Priority items and FRPM % in 21st CCLC funding
- FRPM vs. community meal provisions
- TK/ K hours requirements
- School closure due to strike
- School site substitutions—continuing the conversation based off the SSEL feedback
