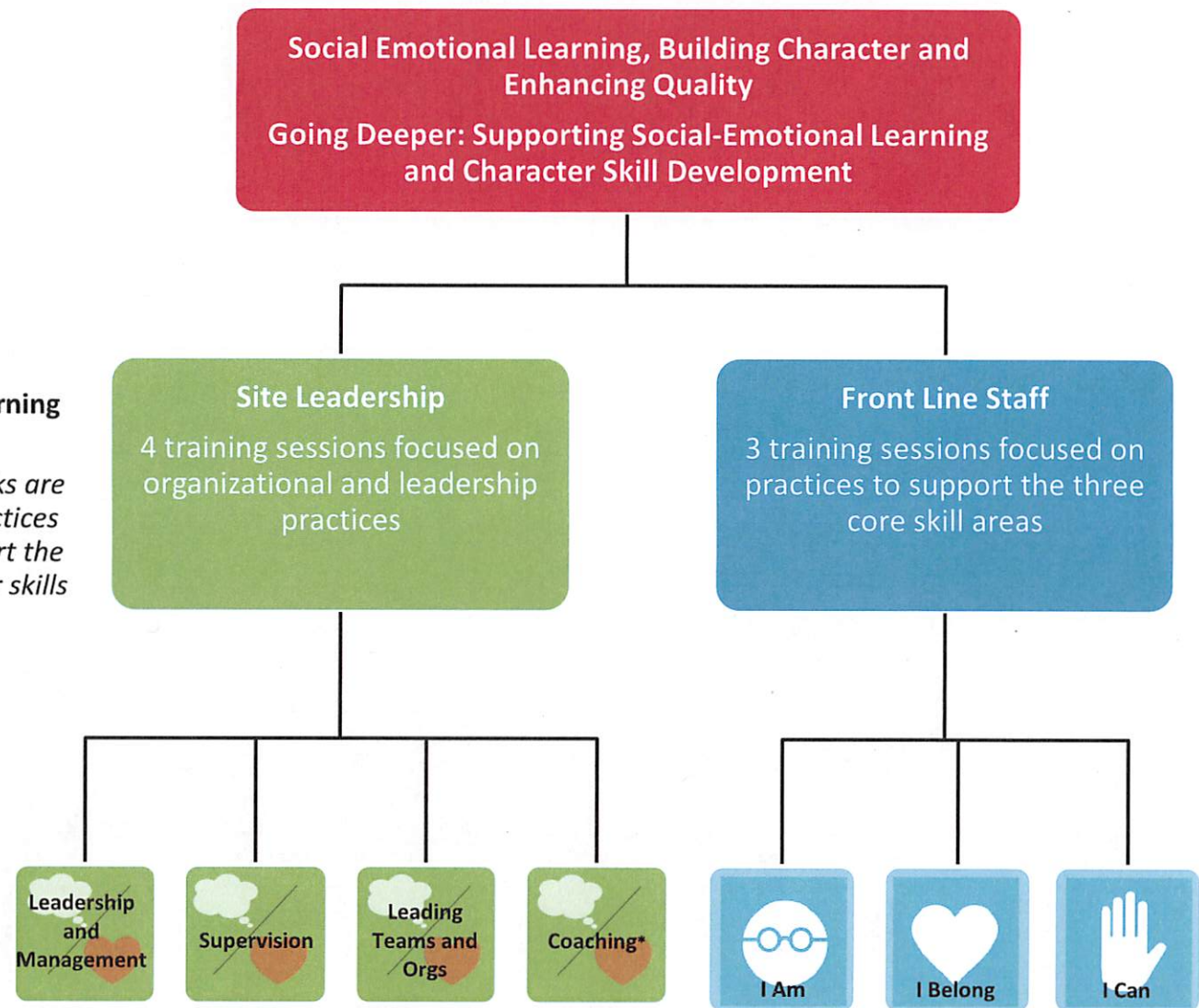
Step 1: Awareness Building

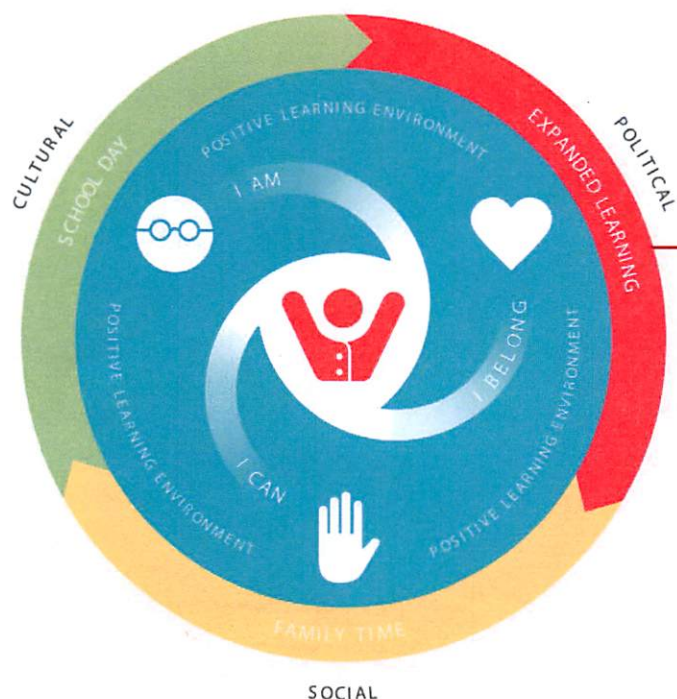
