### **Thursday, August 15: Attendance and Expenditure Revisions Due**

### **Friday, September 20: Annual Outcome Based Data for Evaluation Due**

### **Thursday, October 31: School Site Substitution Form Due**

- Programs are able to request a school site substitution if all of the requirements are met. If submitted and approved by October 31, it can be applied to the current fiscal year.
